Voices of the Gold Road Profiles Lesson: Ghana Empire

Objectives

Students will explore the complexities of the history of the Ghana Empire through active participation and critical thinking.

Materials Needed

<u>Ghana Profile Powerpoint</u> <u>Ghana Profile Badges</u> (See instructions for making them below.) <u>Listening Organizer</u> Discussion Questions

Procedure

- 1. Distribute badges. Assist if students need help pronouncing names or words.
- 2. Open the Profile <u>PowerPoint</u> and follow the directions
- 3. After all the names have been called, engage students in post-discussion questions.

Discussion Questions

- 1. How did you feel when reading the statement?
- 2. What did you learn about the person's perspective?
- 3. What surprised you?

MAKING BADGES

Materials needed:

- 1. Printable Badges PDF
- 2. Printer
- 3. Cardstock paper
- 4. Scissors or a paper trimmer
- 5. Double stick tape
- 6. Hole puncher
- 7. Ribbon

Instructions:

- 1. Print the <u>PRINTABLE BADGES PDF</u> on cardstock.
- 2. Cut out the cards. There are 2 cards (front and back) per page. The front has the image and the back has the description.
- 3. Fold the cards in half, so that the front image is on one side and the back description is on the other side.
- 4. Place a piece of double-stick tape inside each badge to keep it from opening up.
- 5. Punch a hole at the top of each card.
- 6. Tie a ribbon through the hole and you're done.
